**Local Area and Definition:** Nyngan District to comprise Bogan, Bourke, Brewarrina, Cobar and Warren Shires, and both horse and rider must reside in the Nyngan Show District or be an active member of Nyngan or Tottenham Pony Clubs for a period of 28 days prior to the Show. Any bona fide residents who do not comply with the above conditions and wish to ride in district events may apply to the Secretary in writing 7 days prior to the Show for consideration of special dispensation. A committee of Ringmaster, President and Vice President to rule on any application received. Any horse or rider competing illegally in district events will be disqualified from taking any further part in the current Nyngan Show.

**LOCAL CLASSES** - Jackets are Not required

Nyngan Show is run under ASC, EA & SHC Rules. Stallions cannot compete in a ridden class - except breed classes - they MUST wear a bit in all classes - Excludes Show Jumping.

**Entry & Conditions**

Bridle number, entry fee, ASC Horse Health Declaration & ASC Individual waiver – a \$10 per horse entry fee applies for the show ring events and covers entry into any of show ring events (excluding show jumping, barrels and working stock horse). ASC declarations & waivers available from [www.nynganshow.com](http://www.nynganshow.com).

No bridle number &/or wristband equals no ring entry. All riders must wear EA approved Safety Helmets and regulation riding boots must be worn and waivers completed for each event entered otherwise entry will be refused. **PIC NUMBERS MUST BE PROVIDED.** There will be fireworks Sunday night.

Competitors MUST get a bridle number for each horse, clear details must be given, ASC Waivers signed & a \$10.00 event fee paid. In rider classes the rider must give their name to the Steward if placed. One bridle number per horse only. One wristband per rider only. Fees & waivers can be sent to the Secretary prior to the Show.

ANY competitor thought to be trying to misuse this system will risk disqualification of all Nyngan Show results and non-recording of qualifications with ASC, EA, RAS, VAS & SHC.

**No events will be held up for competitors in other rings.** Only competitors and Show officials are allowed in the main arena. Assistance and/or coaching from outside the arena is not allowed and will result in the competitor being dismissed from the Show.

Any competitors who are awarded a Champion or Reserve Champion in Ring A Sunday are not eligible to compete in hack classes in Ring. B. The Ringmaster reserves the right to make alterations.

Any misconduct on the part of the competitor or parent/guardian of under 18's may result in the refusal of future entries of the competitor/parent/guardian or entry to future Nyngan Shows.

Pleasure Events to be ridden in a snaffle, no spurs or whips. Pleasure Champions are NOT eligible for Supreme.

Drug testing may be carried out at this Show. Competitors must show exhibits as either Show Hunter or Hack, for the duration of the show. Height certificates will be accepted from RAS, EA, & VAS.

All ponies, galloways & hacks must be measured if they do not have a current height certificate. All Child's Pony, Child's Galloway or Child's Hack classes - the child must be under 17.

**Only Local Champions are eligible for the Local Supreme Horse and Local Supreme Rider of the Show. Ribbons will be presented on Monday for all Sunday Show ring events, in Ring A. Competitors for the Supremes must be available to be judged on Monday and presentations will be made at the Grand Opening in Ring A, they must be ridden in a snaffle bridle.**

The Ringmaster &/or Stewards may ask for relevant CURRENT registration papers to be shown to them, all competitors must produce these papers or they will be disqualified, and the result/s will not be recorded. Owners must also be members of their breed society.

Nyngan Show Society does NOT accept any responsibility for any damage or injury caused by any horse or competitor whilst in attendance at the Show.

The Nyngan Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program and judges, and/or to reject any entries/competitor/exhibit, without giving any reason.

### OFF THE TRACK NSW INC OFFICIAL QUALIFYING REGULATIONS

1. Off The Track is open to all Thoroughbreds that have been lodged in a stable return for pre training and. race preps, have officially raced or barrier trialled, locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years and over and be no less than 14.2hh. All horses will be **Registered with Racing Australia**. Registrations and stable returns for those that did not make it to the races will be checked.
2. Racing Name is to be used. Other than those that were unnamed due to injuries etc, during pre-training. In this instance, please contact us before entering classes for your clearance.
3. Qualifying shows must be affiliated with The Agricultural Societies of NSW Ltd, or Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.
4. Off The Track NSW Qualifying classes will be judged as separate classes. Led, Ridden, Show jumping & Dressage. Any horse that has won Champion cannot compete in other qualifiers within the season.
5. The season is a calendar year. Any place getters at other finals are **NOT** Permitted to enter the Off The Track NSW Inc Finals/Championships. Please choose your finals ahead of time. Once an OTT has won Champion, that horse cannot compete in other qualifiers within the season. Horses that have won Reserve Champion or Runner up may continue. Any horse that has won a Champion or Reserve Off The Track NSW in the past 3 years but has NOT won a place at other finals are eligible to enter the Off The track NSW Inc Finals/Championships. This includes Off The Track NSW Show Jumping Champions.
6. Random drug testing may be carried out. The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the programme/schedule at their discretion.
7. Horses will be judged as a good example of a thoroughbred, rather than that of a riding horse/hunter type, with the following taken into consideration
  - Thoroughbred qualities, Conformation, Manners, paces and performance
  - Injuries caused through racing, such as blemishes, are allowed
8. Judges decision is final in the qualifiers, and the state finals/championships
9. Horse and owner must reside in NSW to compete in the Off The Track NSW INC Series

Every horse that enters the finals/championships must be ridden by the same rider that qualified the horse.
